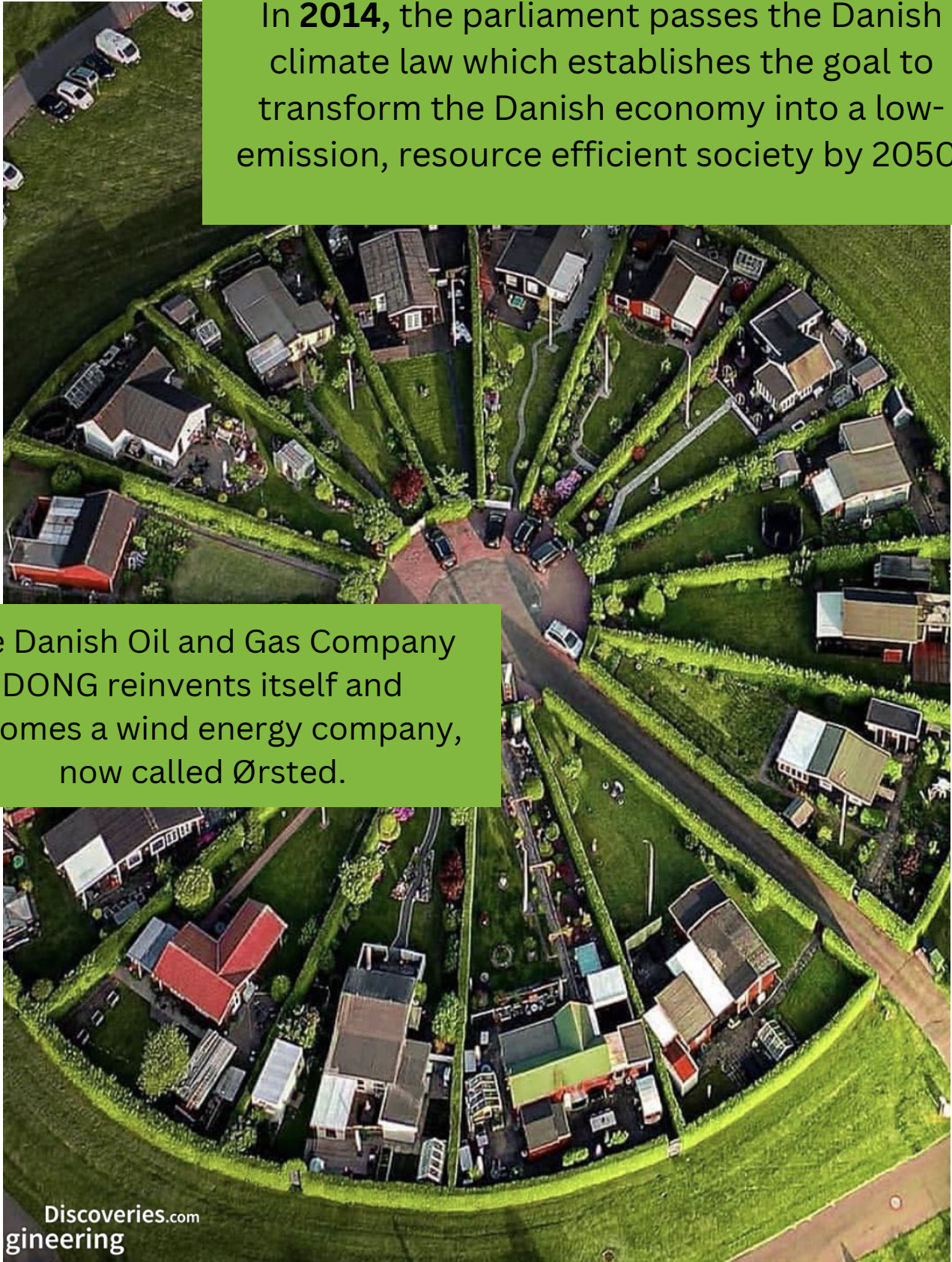

In **2014**, the parliament passes the Danish climate law which establishes the goal to transform the Danish economy into a low-emission, resource efficient society by 2050.

The Danish Oil and Gas Company DONG reinvents itself and becomes a wind energy company, now called Ørsted.



2014

The Danish climate law is passed, aiming to create a low-emission society by 2050.

2015

The government sets a goal of phasing out fossil fuels by 2050.

2017

The Danish People's Party introduces a price competition between solar and wind power technology.

2020

The Danish Parliament reaches an agreement to ban oil and gas extraction from the North Sea.

2021

Denmark launches the **Beyond Oil & Gas Alliance (BOGA)**, an alliance of governments determined to set an end date for their oil and gas exploration and extraction.

2022

Denmark's government announces a goal to make domestic flights fossil fuel free by 2030.
